Candidate has the required minimum equipment.		
Has completed an American Red Cross Basic First Aid and CPR course or better. Alternative equivalency must be pre-approved by the Training Officer.		
Has completed an American Red Cross Basic Canine First Aid course or better. Alternative equivalency must be pre-approved by the Training Officer.		
NASAR SARTECH III Certification – Online Test (The book required is Introduction to Search and Rescue – can be found on NASAR.com website)		
Has completed ICS/NIMS courses IS-100, IS-200 and IS-700.		
A minimum of 8 hours participation at base providing radio communications, mapping, security and care of canines left at base. NOTE: VCC Search Management Course can be substituted for this requirement.		
Has functional knowledge of GPS operations, downloading, printing and plotting maps. Is able to maintain a map of the route and location of a canine team in the field using reports of UTM coordinates and other information received via radio/cell communications.		
Must demonstrate functional knowledge of radio communications according to radio standards. Demonstrate ability to maintain a base log.		
Has functional knowledge of how to deal with outside influences such as family members or the media.		

## FIELD SUPPORT REQUIREMENTS EVALUATION RECORD for \_\_\_\_\_

Candidate must have completed K9SM Base Support Certification before Field Support Certification is complete. Once both base and field support certifications have been attained, you will receive operational status with K9SM.

Any evaluator for the following check-offs must have their field support certification. Proof of certifications must be current and provided to the evaluator prior to signing off on the completion of the check-off. A certificate will be given upon completing all of your Field Support requirements. Please file it with your records and other certifications.

*Demonstrate ability to tie (4) required K9SM Knots with rope and webbing. (a water knot, swiss seat harness, prussic sling, and figure eight knot.)		
Has functional knowledge of basic crime scene control measures. <i>LE crime scene preservation class or online <a href="http://www.k9handleracademy.com/CrimeScene.html">http://www.k9handleracademy.com/CrimeScene.html</a>.</i>		
Candidate can build an improvised shelter.		
Start a fire without use of matches or lighter.		
Demonstrate proper use of a signal mirror.		
Complete a hike of three (3) miles over varied terrain in 90 minutes or less.		
* Pass the NSSDN Field Support/Canine written Test online. <i>Prepare by reading the NASAR Fundamentals for Search and Rescue</i>		
Personal Training/Certification Log (may be included in Canine Log). This log should contain a record of all other training as well as any certifications earned and actual missions.		
Lift a 50 lb. item onto and off the tailgate of a full-size pickup truck. It should be a clean lift (don't drag the item out of the truck and let it fall to the ground).		
With a partner, carry a 200 lb. load a distance of 50 feet. This can be done as either a blanket or a stretcher carries.		
Observer or Field Support on training exercises, mock search or missions totaling 10 hours of field experience.		
In an area of approximately 10 acres, the team shall simply walk and flag on two boundaries a pre-determined grid pattern, to demonstrate the handler's proficiency at walking a grid in a straight line.		
*Mantracking Field Test. Prepare by reading recommended resources.		
*Map and Compass Field Test		
GPS Field Test. Includes five geocaches or locations.		
*Line Search and Lane Search Test.
